


Two Types of Cat Toys

Lavender or Chamomile Sock Toys

Braided Hanging Kitten Toys

Our kittens love to play with these hanging braided ropes! We tie them to the inside of their kitty kennels and hang a noisy toy from the bottom. Our cats give it a "2-Paws Up" rating!



- 1) Start with 3 strips of 18" x 2" fleece material
- 2) Tie a knot at one end of the toy and leave enough material so that we can tie the toy to the kennel



- 3) Braid material together IMPORTANTmake sure it is braided VERY tightly!
- 4) Tie a knot at the END of the toy and leave enough material so we can tie a toy at the end
